

TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF VARIOUS ROADS, BRIDPORT FOR BRIDPORT CARNIVAL

DORSET COUNCIL has made an Order under Section 16A of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to prohibit the use of the following roads by cyclists, horse riders and all mechanically propelled vehicles, except mobility scooters and powered wheelchairs in class 2 and 3, those taking part in the event and emergency vehicles, to facilitate a public event on the highway.

On Saturday 22 August 2026 between 1600 and 2359 as follows:

The effect of this Order will be, to impose temporary road closures on;

- West Allington in its entirety - 1600 to 2000
- Part West Road, from the access road of Symondsburys Estate to West Allington - 1600 to 2000
- South Street in its entirety - 1830 to 2130
- West Street in its entirety - 1830 to 2130
- Part South Street, from its junction with West Street to its junction with Gundry Lane - 1700 to 2359

A locally signed diversion route will be put in place to enable traffic to travel around the closed section.
